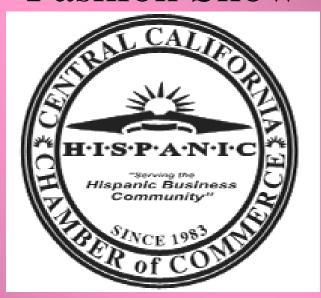

Founder and President of Los Kitos Entertainment LLC

Martha Montoya is the Founder and President of Los Kitos and Chair of the LA Metro Hispanic Chamber of Commerce. She is also a board member of the California Hispanic Chambers of Commerce (State Organization) & the United States Hispanic Chamber of Commerce.

Upon immigrating to the United States, Martha developed a business career in International Trade, in areas such as telecommunications, agriculture and many more, which has helped her establish herself as a business leader and community advocate.

Currently, Martha owns and directs a unique media enterprise, Los Kitos Entertainment LLC, which has three main divisions. The core business is the syndication, through Tribune Media, of the inspirational Los Kitos bilingual cartoon strip to over 300 Spanish language newspapers in the United States including the Los Angeles based, La Opinion. A second division is the licensing of the characters to over 25 licensees ranging from Good Humor Ice Cream, to State Farm Insurance; to assist those companies expand their presence in the Hispanic market. The third division of LKELLC is utilizing the characters to bring edu-entertainment to the U.S. Hispanic community.

Through out her career in the U.S. she developed a keen sense of the market and her experience selling products and services to the Hispanic market expands 15 years, during which she worked with the telecommunications industry, food and service industries in various campaigns that were directed to employees, manufacturers, suppliers, retailers consumers and business community.

Her latest endeavor is spearheading the Access to Business Capital (ABC) Program for Venture Capital. Recognizing that access to capital is the No. 1 issue for business owners, she took the steps to establish this program in 2004 and recruited the support of various Venture Capitalists and other institutions with the goal of not only providing funds for business, but looking into the future, to also provide the tools to integrate research and education into the program. Program partners include prestigious entities such as Microsoft Corporation, 1st PMF Bancorp, Fontis Capital, Engage Capital, Fulcrum Capital, Nogales Investors, Rosewood Capital, Yucaipa Corporate Initiatives Fund, Fontis Capital, U.S. MBDA, Fortius Holdings, Coface – North America, Palladium Equity and Comerica.

With 25 years of professional experience, Ms. Angelica Aragon is recognized as one of the most talented and loved actresses in the Spanish entertainment.

In spite of her multiple duties, she dedicates her time to support social causes that impact women and children.

Her international movies credits include hits such as: "Pueblo de Madera", "Gertrudis Bocanegra", "Un Paseo por las Nubes" and recently "La Mujer de mi Hermano" (2005); "Párpados Azules" plus the critically acclaimed "El Crímen del Padre Amaro" (2002)

Ms. Aragon is well respected in Hollywood for her work in "Picking up the Pieces" (2000), where she was second director and shared credits with Woody Allen, Sharon Stone, Kiefer Sutherland and David Schwimmer; "Dirty Dancing: Habana nights" and "Looking for Palladin" (2004).

Her numerous awards include the Ariel as Best Actress in "Cilantro y Perejil" (1995) and Best Female Co-Actress in "El Crimen del Padre Amaro" (2002).

A theatrical highlight was her participation and Co-Directing the act "Ixok", highlighting women's rights.

In TV Azteca her participation in "Mirada de Mujer" was an ice breaker in the novelas history role of the traditional Latin woman. "La Chacala" (1998); "Todo por Amor" (2000); and "Mirada de Mujer, el regreso" (2003) reaffirmed her superstar status. Azteca America has recently confirmed her participating in the much anticipated mini series "Ni una vez mas I and II", a series highlighting violence towards women.
